




**Year 2**

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy</b></p> 	<p>This term the children will be :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read aloud The Owl and the Pussycat</li><li>• Illustrate, sequence and dramatise the poem</li><li>• Ordering events and acting out the story of The Owl and the Pussycat</li><li>• Read and enjoy poems about owls and cats</li><li>• Understand the difference in meaning between homophones</li><li>• Read owl stories</li><li>• Keep a diary as the character Plop</li><li>• Write a character description</li><li>• Create their own story about an owl</li><li>• Research water voles and write facts</li><li>• RWI/ SPAG session 3x a week</li></ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mathematics</b></p> 	<p>This term the children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers mentally</li><li>• Counting on in 2s,3s,5s and 10s from any 2- digit number</li><li>• Recalling multiplication and division facts for the 2,3, 5 and 10 x tables</li><li>• Doubling any number up to 50 and working out half of any even number up to 100</li><li>• Finding <math>\frac{1}{2}</math>, <math>\frac{1}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{3}{4}</math> of a length, shape and set of objects</li><li>• Telling the time to 5 minutes including quarter past and quarter to</li><li>• Know that there are different ways to express a time.e.g. eight thirty-five is 35 minutes past 8 or 25 to 9</li><li>• Solving problems with measures- cm, m g, kg, ml and l</li></ul>

<p><b>Connected Curriculum (Topic Theme)</b></p> 	<p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using a poem as a stimuli</li> <li>• Finding out about nocturnal animals</li> <li>• Exploring owls and cats</li> <li>• Comparing different pieces of music</li> <li>• Creating and designing own owl collage</li> </ul>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>This half term the topic is called ' We are painters'. This will involve looking at illustrations, planning and storing illustrations and making an e-book about an owl story.</p>
<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>The children will be learning songs for the Morning of Music event held at Gosford Park school on the 20<sup>th</sup> of March. They will learn percussion parts to accompany the songs and will have a practice performance to parents on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March at 2.40pm.</p> <p>The children will continue to learn musical skills and will listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high- quality live and recorded music.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>This half term children will be studying the Easter story and learning about how Jesus came back to life.(Resurrection)</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>The children will have PE sessions on Thursdays with Elite.</p> <p>Please make sure they have their kits in school on the Monday after half term.</p>
