








**The Best We Can Be**

**Year 1**

<p><b>Literacy</b></p> 	<p>This term children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Reading a selection of stories during the unit with predictable and patterned language.</li><li>• Use written instructions in the form of labels, captions and lists</li><li>• Reading stories with familiar settings and writing their own story.</li></ul>
<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> 	<p>This term children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.</li><li>• identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least..</li><li>• read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.</li><li>• identify one more and one less.</li><li>• read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.</li><li>• add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.</li><li>• solve simple one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems.</li><li>• recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity</li></ul>
<p><b>Connected Curriculum (Topic Theme)</b></p>	<p>This term children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In History children will learn to make a timeline of their toy, Identify similarities and differences of toys and find out about changes within living memory.</li><li>• In Art children will be using different</li></ul>

	<p>textures and media to create designs, portraits and hand printing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In Design Technology children will be looking at baby toys and designing and making a book.</li> <li>• In Science children will learn to identify basic needs, name parts of the body, understand and identify their five senses and learn the importance of healthy living.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>In computing the children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Become familiar with using Ipads</li> <li>• Develop their understanding of programming and learn to programme toys, such as bee-bots.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>This term the children will be learning hip-hop songs written for schools. Children will develop their listening and performing skills as well as begin to understand the different dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch, etc.)</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>In R.E. children will learning to understand about creation and how God wants Christians to look after the world.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Children will have PE lessons on <b>Tuesdays</b> and <b>Thursdays</b>. Please make sure they have their kits in school.</p> <p>Tuesday: Elite session Thursday: Elite session</p>
