



<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> 	<p>This term the children will be :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recounts- History link- visitor talking about the seaside in the past • Learning how to use conjunctions and subordinate clauses • Researching and writing information about the seaside in the past • Reading seaside stories written by well-known authors • Exploring adjectives and verbs that create tension in stories • Write own seaside story using adjectives and verse to create tension • Daily SPAG sessions • Daily Handwriting sessions • RWI/ SPAG session 3x a week
<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> 	<p>This term the children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers mentally • Counting on in 2s,3s,5s and 10s from any 2- digit number • Recalling multiplication and division facts for the 2,3, 5 and 10 x tables • Using different strategies to solve all 4 operations. • Doubling any number up to 50 and working out half of any even number up to 100 • Finding $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape and set of objects • Telling the time to 5 minutes including quarter past and quarter to

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that there are different ways to express a time. e.g. eight thirty-five is 35 minutes past 8 or 25 to 9 • Solving problems with measures • Identifying and naming the properties of 2D and 3D shapes
<p>Connected Curriculum (Topic Theme)</p> 	<p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Looking at the coast in the UK • Learn countries, capitals and seas in and around the U.K. • Research the seaside in the past • Study seaside entertainment, clothes and transport used 100 years ago. • Sorting different materials and their properties.
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In computing the topic is called 'We are celebrating'. This will involve researching different types of cards, practising using the keyboard on an Ipad, creating images and then combining the image and refining the card.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>The children will learn songs linked to the seaside incorporating all the musical elements of pitch, dynamics, pulse, tempo, rhythm and timbre. They will also listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high- quality live and recorded music from different eras. The children will experiment with, create, select, and combine sounds using a variety of percussion instruments.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This half term the children will be studying Islam- Hajj. Does completing Hajj make a person a better Muslim?</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>The children will have two PE this half term on Wednesdays and Fridays. Please make sure they have their kits in school. Wednesday Games and Friday- Elite sessions</p>
<p>Additional Information</p>	<p>A visitor will be coming into class to talk to the children about seaside holidays 60 years ago. The children will also need to bring a photo of themselves either at the seaside or on a day trip to a park etc.. Year 2 will also be going on their school trip to Warwick Castle on Wednesday 21st June 2017.</p>
