



<p>D+T</p> <p>Use objects from around the house and turn them into a musical toy. Ask them to tell you their favourite toys and games when they were a child. Write down what they said in sentences.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Choose your favourite healthy snack and write instructions on how to make it.</p>
<p>English</p> <p>Guess the toy!</p> <p>Write a description of a toy and attach a hidden picture (e.g. under a flap). We can see if others can guess what your toy is from the description.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Make a bar chart or pictogram to show the favourite toy of 10 friends.</p> 	<p>Art</p> <p>Create two portraits. One to show you as a baby and one to show you as a child now. You could use pencils, paints, chalks, etc.</p>
<p>Maths</p> <p>One More and One Less!</p> <p>Find the missing number on the sheet provided.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Make a moving skeleton and label the main different body parts.</p> <p>(You could draw a body shape if the movement is too tricky!)</p>	<p>History</p> <p>Research your favourite toy - find out when it was invented and who created it.</p>

Children, complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line, which must include the middle square! Colour in each square as you complete that activity. (If you would like to do more than 3 challenges that would be great!)
