English/ Spellings

Each week you will have spellings related to a phoneme or pattern to learn. There will be a test each Monday.

History

Research one of the Roman or Viking gods and present your findings as a fact file. Provide interesting details and myths or tales they feature in.



Art / DT

Paint, draw or sculpt your very own Anglo-Saxon or Viking ship which would have sailed in to reach the shores of

Britain so the invaders could then settle here thousands of years



Science/English

We will be finding out about light and shadows this half-term. Design and make a shadow puppet. If you are feeling really adventurous you might like to make Viking themed puppet/puppets and tell a Viking story you have researched!

Reading

Reading is one of the most important skills you can have in life!

As we are starting a new year your tasks are:

- to make sure you read <u>EVERY</u>
 <u>DAY (for fun and challenge)!</u>
- to take your new reading diary home daily and ask a family member to hear you read so they can then complete the diary. You can show your diary as evidence in Tic Tac Toe assembly.
- to complete your Bug Club reading task each week so you are ready to join in with class discussions by Friday.

Geography

Draw and label the countries of Europe showing where the Romans, Anglo-Saxons and Vikings came from. Draw their journey to Britain using arrows.

Label seas, oceans and other geographical aspects such as capital cities, main rivers.



Art

The Romans are famous for their mosaic art. Do some research to find out about mosaics before creating your own. You could use coloured tiles or felt pens, paint, colour paper etc.



Maths

This year you will be learning 'Roman Numerals' as part of your maths curriculum. Find out how Roman numerals work. Create a poster to teach others the important facts.
